Prayer Meeting Leader Information

About a year ago God placed a strong desire in my heart to start a prayer meeting focused on praying for unreached nations around the world. After experimenting with various approaches, I've developed a process that works (I believe) really well and I want to share it with the world.

Weekly Guide

Each weekly guide includes:

• **Bible Verse**: A verse to anchor our prayers and discussions. Ask general questions about it like "what does this mean for us?" "Why did Jesus say this?" Etc.

• **Story**: A story from around the world to connect us with the realities of the unreached and missionaries.

- Missionary Quote: A convicting quote from a missionary.
- **Stunning Facts**: Eye-opening facts about the unreached nations and just the dark realities of the fallen earth.
- **Praise Report:** A way God is doing great things around the world amidst trials.
- **Prayer Points**: Specific areas to focus our prayers.
- Action Items: Practical steps we can take in response to the discussion.

Something that makes this weekly guide unique, is that it includes current events, updated data, and is always being updated. So if something happens around the world - it may show up in that weeks guide.

Additionally, at the end of each guide, there are resources and materials for further research.

How to Use the Guide

This is not a rigid curriculum, but a flexible guide to support and start your prayer meetings. Each week you will have verses, quotes, and prayer points that are related, providing a cohesive focus for every meeting.

Preparation:

- Spend a few moments in prayer before the meeting.
- Add any additional information or make adjustments as you feel led.

• Allow conversations and prayers to flow naturally, guided by the Holy Spirit.

Our goal is to encourage one another to love, good works, and grow in our relationship with Jesus for our joy and His glory.

By following this guide, you can confidently lead prayer meetings for the unreached, knowing you have meaningful content to inspire and direct your conversations and prayers.
